RULES FOR EDITING AN APPENDIX BIBLIOGRAPHY

Any scientific article (this does not apply to a review, report or discussion) should be accompanied by a list of bibliography used by the author.

The bibliography list should not be integrated into the text, but uploaded with other metadata when the article is submitted through the platform *Editorial System*: https://www.editorialsystem.com/snt

In the process of editing the Bibliography, the PRINCIPLES OF REFERENCES are generally applicable, with the following whereby:

- each entry begins with the name and initial of the first name (if known) or the name of the body publishing the text in question or the title (in case neither the author's data nor the author's body are known).
- in the case of articles in journals and multi-author works, the beginning and end pages of the text should be accurately indicated, and not just mark the place to which the author refers (as in footnotes)
- if available, provide URLs for bibliographic items.
